- Staff meeting was scheduled on 02.06.2022 for seeking more information from individual faculty members about the progress of the students and their current position of the lecture shortage/ House examination performance etc (Annexure No.).
- Dr. Suman Khokhar, In charge Lecture shortage committee presented the lecture shortage report in the staff meeting held on 02.06.2022 and informed the house that 35 students were having lecture shortage below five lectures and 5 students are facing serious lecture shortage (more than five lectures).
- 3. After deliberation it was unanimously approved by the house that Parent teacher meeting (PTM) may be scheduled for the students having lecture shortage more than five and Principal of the college was authorized to take appropriate decision in consultation with the higher authorities regarding such lecture shortage cases after PTM.
- 4. It was approved by the house that students having genuine reasons and representing the college in different competitions may be given assignment work by the subject teachers in lieu of being absent in the college house examination latest by 10<sup>th</sup> June 2022.
- 5. Principal also informed the house that Panjab University final practical examinations have been
- scheduled from 15<sup>th</sup> June 2022 to 21<sup>st</sup> June 2022 and final theory examinations have been scheduled from 22<sup>nd</sup> June 2022.
- 6. Dr. Sapna Nanda (Dean) suggested faculty members to provide all the required support to the students for improving their academic performance and excelling in the final examination.
