Admission Process: 40% of the total seat intake is open for students from all over India.

Value Education Period: Celebration of important days highlighting National and international cohesiveness, Inclusion, Social and Cultural Diversity etc.

Book Bank: Facility available to the students wherein meritorious and economically backward students are provided textbooks from the library.

Facility of Library in Boys & Girls Hostel: The institution provides a conducive environment for learning by providing Library facility in Boys & Girls Hostel.

The library is situated on the ground floor, which is readily accessible by physically challenged students: The institution provides arrangement to cater the needs of physically challenged students.

Special Classroom arrangement for students with diverse need: Provision of Ramp, wheelchairs and instructional software like Jaws along with smart board.


Relaxation in time for submission of assignment and answer sheets: For students with visual and Loco motor disability.

Guidance and Counselling Cell: College has its own Guidance and Counselling Cell which is equipped with facilities to provide Individual and Group guidance to the students for their educational, social, personal and professional aspect.

Scholarship: College provides scholarship to the reserved category students (SC/ST).
