REPORT OF THE INTERACTIVE SESSION HELD ON 18-12-2021

The Government College of Education, Sector-20 D Science Club, NAVONMESH in collaboration with Indian Association of Physics Teachers IAPT, RC-3, (Regional Council-3 for Chandigarh and Himachal Pradesh) organized an Interactive Session in the blended mode on the topic '21st Century Skills Towards Redefining Science Pedagogy' for the member students of Science Club of the college on Saturday, 18-12-2021 from 10:15 a.m. to 11:45 a.m. The Resource Person for the said event was a very experienced Science Educator, National Awardee teacher Sh. Paramjeet Singh, Lecturer in Physics at GMSSS-Sector-8, Chandigarh and a committed Life Member of IAPT.

The event started with the welcome of the Resource Person Sh. Paramjeet Singh and the Guest of Honour, Prof. C.N. Kumar, President IAPT RC-3 by our worthy Principal Dr. A.K. Srivastava. It was followed by introduction of the Science Club and theme of the day by Dr. Sanjeev Kumar, Associate Professor and the Convener of the programme. Prof. C.N. Kumar, in his address briefed the audience about IAPT and its activities/ programmes for quality science education and wished this programme a great success in inspiring the students of pedagogy of science. Sh. Paramjeet Singh very aptly contextualized his interactive presentation with NEP-2020 and highlighted the four pillars of quality science pedagogy for the 21st century. He discussed in detail how 24x7 high-quality active science learning is possible through use of various open-source digital tools and platforms widely available for free. He demonstrated the use of 'PhET Simulations' (developed by Colorado University) in visualizing the experiments of Science like Reflection and Refraction of light, Dispersion of Light through prism and electricity and magnetism related experiments for school level. The students enjoyed the session thoroughly and asked many questions to clarify their doubts. He also explained the use of Microsoft tool 'Sway' for interactive teaching learning of Science and demonstrated how an interesting as well as effective digital lesson plans with proper feedback and comprehensive evaluation embedded in it can be prepared using these tools. It was a great learning session for all the student members of the Science Club Navonmesh.

The programme was compeered by Poonam Sharma, B.Ed. 1st Semester student and President of the Science Club. Vote of thanks was proposed by Secretary of the Science Club Umisha Kalia,

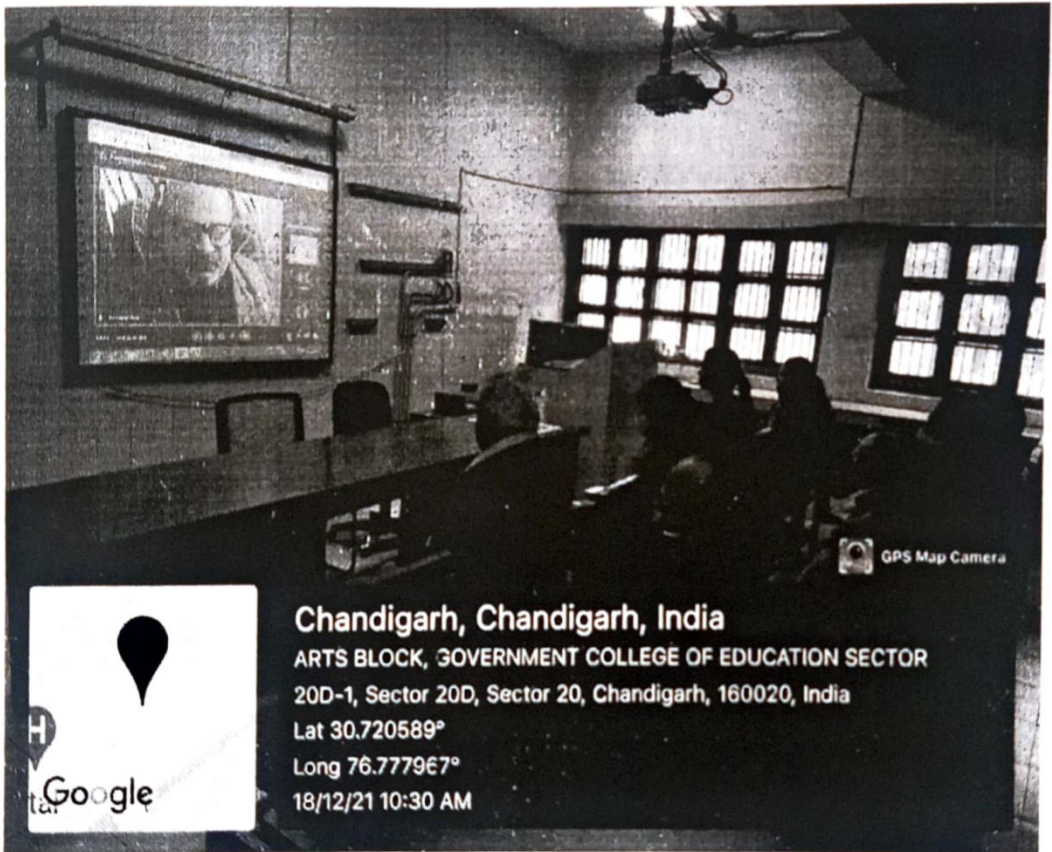

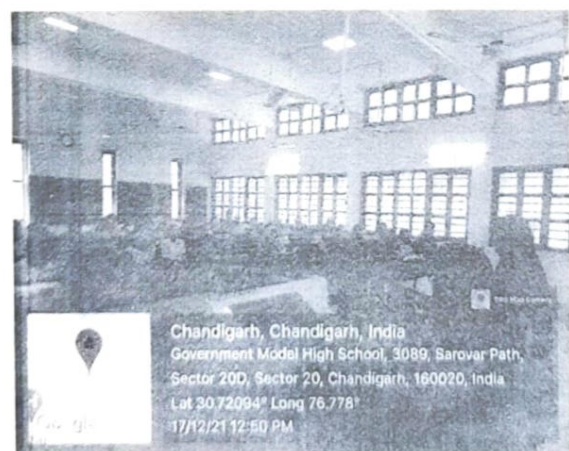

Development of Audio-Visual Teaching Aids

The skill in teaching committee of Govt. College of Education, Sector-20D, Chandigarh organised a workshop on "Development of Audio-Visual Teaching Aids" on 21st October, 2021 for B.Ed. 3rd semester students. The workshop was organised By Skill-in-teaching Coordinator Dr. Kusum along with members Mr. Ravinder Kumar and Dr. Upasna Thapliyal with a purpose of acquainting students with the know-how of preparing different types of teaching aids like working models, charts, flash cards, etc. Principal Dr. A. K. Srivastava inaugurated this workshop. Students participated with full fervour in the workshop. The participants were asked to prepare teaching aid on any one of the pedagogy subjects assigned to them.

B. Ed. 3rd Semester students participated in the workshop. COVID-19 protocols were abided during the conduct of offline workshop. Students had to write a brief note about the teaching aid including its title, topic and relevance. The workshop commenced at 9:30 a.m. and three hours were given to the participants to prepare the aid. Students then displayed the teaching aids prepared by them.

Since the workshop intended to provide firsthand experience of teaching aids preparation to the B.Ed. students, the students were motivated to use teaching aids effectively in their classroom teaching and make it an integral part of their curriculum transaction process. The workshop acted as a preparatory platform in order to prepare students for forthcoming School Internship Program from 23/10/21.

Teaching aids were divided into three categories according to the pedagogy subjects in the following manner:

Category I comprised of languages namely- Hindi/English/Punjabi/Sanskrit. Dr. Anjali Puri, Dr. Mukhtiar Singh, and Dr. Ravneet Chawla were the judges for this category.

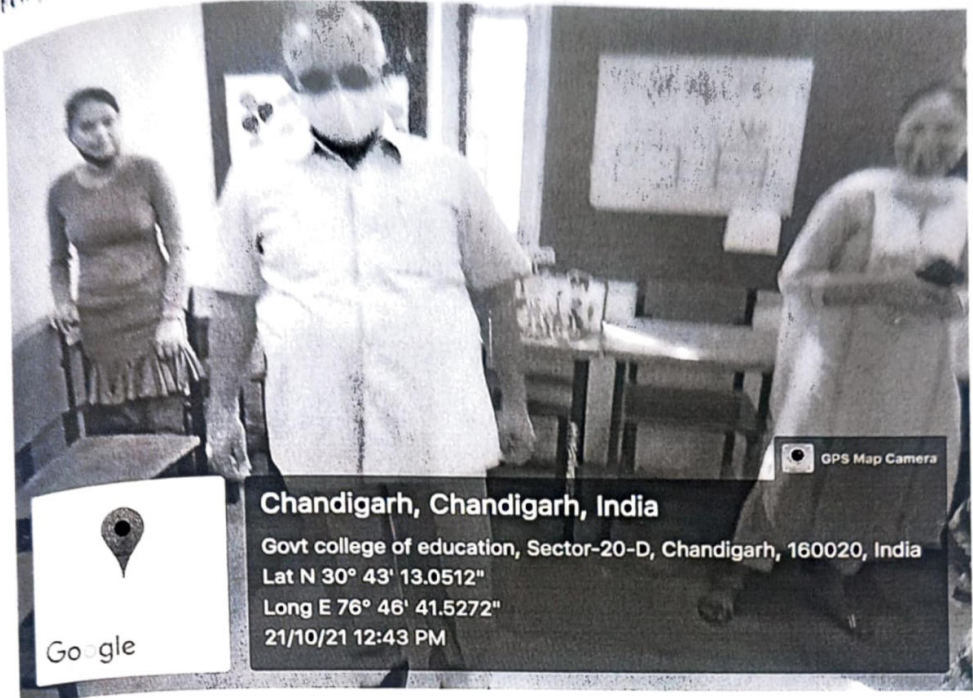

A WORKSHOP on 'SCIENCE BEHIND INDIAN CALENDAR'

An Initiative of Jigyasa - The Science Club

A REPORT

The Science Club of Government College of Education -JIGYASA- organized a two-days workshop entitled "Samvatsar: Indian Calendar" on the topic of 'Ancient Indian Calendar- A Scientific Perspective' from 11:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. for all the students and faculty members of the college. On the first day, Convener of the programme Dr. Sanjeev Kumar, Associate Professor in Chemistry, introduced the theme and Principal Dr. A.K. Srivastava welcomed the renowned resource person Mrs. Anuradha Goyal. Ms Simran Khoshla of B.Ed. 2nd semester formally introduced the resource person and highlighted the significant contributions made by Ma'm Goyal in this and related areas. About 80 students of the college attended this programme on the first day in online mode. During her presentation, the resource person highlighted the need, importance and scientific principles behind our calendar. She highlighted the comprehensiveness of Indian Calendar and explained how it is based on the movements of Sun and Moon in context of the position of Earth, whereas the Gregorian calendar is based totally on the Solar movements and the Islamic calendar is based on Lunar Movements. Thus, Indian Calendar is extremely scientific and comprehensive based on minute details of the movement of constellations. Students actively participated in the program which was evident from their questions and responses.

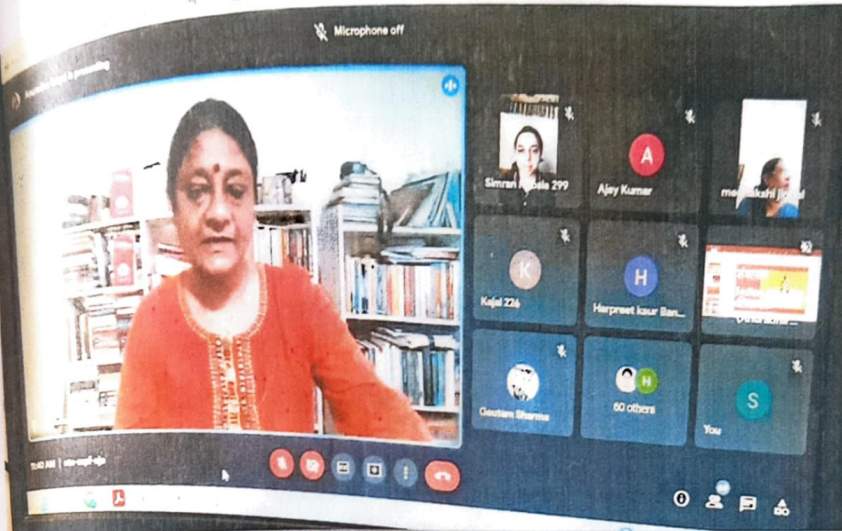
On the second day of the program, the learned resource person started with quick recap of the topics covered on the first day and further explained very systematically and scientifically how Tithi, Vaar, Paksh, Sankranti, Maas, Ritu Varsh, Ayan and Muhurta are calculated in Indian calendar. She also explained how the names of months have been given in Indian calendar. The discussion was extremely interesting and uniquely appealing to our students. She also explained the concept of Parv and Brahma Muhurta and their significance in scientific parlance. The session was followed by extensive question-answers from the spell-bound audience. At last a vote of thanks was proposed by Ms Mitanksha Taneja, a student of B.Ed. second semester of the college. The three faculty members of Science Department of the college Dr. Sanjeev Kumar, Dr. Sheojee Singh and Dr. Lilu Ram Jakhar co-ordinated the smooth organization of the program with the students of Science club of the college.
