Report on Jaipur Udaipur trip

Date - 25th March 2019

Time - 7:30 P.M.

All the students were directed to reach the college premises by the time so that bus can start on time for a long journey of around 12 hours . 
Day-1

Time - 10:30 A.M.

Finally bus reached our destination , i.e. , Jaipur – Hotel TGI Apple In and all students were served ready breakfast because rooms were not ready yet so students kept their luggage in the hotel lobby and enjoyed the delicious sole satisfying meal . In the mean time our trip agent got the rooms allotted for students , followed by their check-in to the respective rooms in quad sharing for relaxing and freshing up . This entire process took around 1 to 1.5 hours and finally by 12 P.M everyone was accommodated . Teacher told students that they need to get ready by 1:30 P.M. for their lunch so that we can utilise most of our time in exploring the pink city .

1 mie - 2:30 P.M.

Finally bus started for our 1st destination, i.e. The Laxmi Narayan Temple, popularly known as Birla Temple. It is a Hindu temple located in Jaipur, India and is part of one of the several Birla Mandirs located all around the country. The grand temple is located on an elevated ground at the base of Moti Dungari hill in Rajasthan. This temple forms one of the most beautiful attractions of Jaipur. It looks stunning, when it is brightly lit in the night. Finest quality of white marble was used in the construction of this beautiful temple where the main attraction is of the images of Lakshmi and Narayan, being made out from one piece of marble. As photography was strictly prohibited in the temple area students captured the mesmerising beauty with their eyes and clicked group pictures in front of the temple and enjoyed cold drinks and ice cream to beat the heat from small shops near the main gate of the temple.







After this beautiful temple visit bus moved ahead for our 2nd destination for the day , i.e. The Amber Fort and The Nahargarh Fort . The whole city is almost encircled or filled with so many forts. Of all, Amber or Amer as commonly referred as the most beautiful one. It almost tells you how grand the lives of the Kings here were. The view from the fort is also amazing.

- Amber Fort Amber was once the capital of princely Jaipur state, and the fort the residence of its Rajput rulers. Maharaja Man Singh I, who led Mughal Emperor Akbar's army, commenced its construction in 1592 on the remains of an 11th-century fort. The construction of Amber Fort was started in 1592. It was modified on regular intervals by several rulers and the trend continued up until late 1600. The fort was mostly constructed using red sandstone and white marble. Though basically a fort, it also served as the main residence of the Rajput Maharajas.
- Nahargarh Fort Nahargarh means 'abode of tigers'. It stands on the edge of the Aravalli Hills, overlooking the city of Jaipur . Along with Amber Fort and Jaigarh Fort, Nahargarh once formed a strong defense ring for the city. Built mainly in 1734 by Maharaja Sawai Jai Singh, the king of Jaipur, the fort was constructed as a place of retreat on the summit of the ridge above the city. Walls extended over the surrounding hills, forming fortifications that connected this fort to Jaigarh, the fort above the old capital of Amber.

Our bus was parked in the main parking and it took us 15 min to walk to the main gate of Amber fort. Our teacher divided all 43 students in 4 groups with one leader each so that we can be together and she can be reported our location timely . It is a huge fort with so many corridors and huge open spaces, gardens etc. . A guide was hired by our tour agent to give us all the necessary knowledge about the history of the fort and all the secret information which can't be easily found on internet . He showed us the "SHEESH MAHAL" situated in the fort along with other places where shootings of Bollywood films like Jodha Akbar and Bajirao Mastani was done . Due to paucity of time we need to rush to cover more as even a full day may not be sufficient to cover these large forts. We had to miss the light and music show, which was organised is Nahargarh Fort as we need to travel back for around 1.5 hour to our hotel . The moment we reached our bus we were given water bottles to keep us hydrated.

After this wonderful day we reached our hotel and headed towards the dinning hall where amazing food was waiting us. We had dinner, went to room to relax a bit and got ready for amazing DJ night in our hotel's basement. That was an amazing experience where all of us danced to the beats of DJ and felt disc like feeling with dim lights and loud music. Our feet couldn't resist the beats and no matter how good we were with dance steps we all enjoyed a lot. This all went until 11:30 P.M. after which we all headed towards our rooms for a peaceful and comfortable sleep to rejuvenate our energy for next day journey to Udaipur – the city of lakes.

Day-2

1 mic - 8:30 A.M.

We all got ready, packed our bags and assembled in the hotel dinning room for our breakfast. It was a delicious breakfast containing huge variety to choose from breads and fruits to cornflakes to the regular north Indian breakfast of fried poori with tangy alloo sabzi and good variety of drinks including juice, milk, tea and coffee. We spent around one hour to finish our meal and assembled near the bus and loaded our suitcases for our journey that started around 9:30 A.M. As per our tour guide it was supposed to be a 6 hour journey but it turned out to be way more that expected.

Time - 2:30 P.M.

We had to take a break for lunch and were served a very oily and spicy proper Rajasthan style lunch at a local restaurant on our way . After spending a good 1.5 hour there our bus moved towards our main destination at around 4:00 P.M. This time our tour guide played a Punjabi movie in our bus for our entertainment and make this unexpectedly long journey to be a comfortable one .





Time - 6:30 P.M.

We stopped in Nathdwara town to visit the Shrinathji Temple. Located on the banks of the Banas River and having a distance of 48km from Udaipur, Nathdwara the Gate of the Lord is visited most frequently by Hindu pilgrims. Shrinathji symbolizes a form of Krishna, when he lifted the Govardhan hill, with one arm raised. The image in the form of a single black marble, where the lord is revealed with his left hand raised and the right hand made into a fist resting at the waist, with a large diamond placed beneath the lips. The idol is carved in Bas-relief out of a monolithic black marble stone, with images of two cows, one lion, one snake, two peacocks and one parrot engraved on it and three sages placed near it . The temple has been designed in the lines of Nanda Maharaj (Krishna's father) temple, in Vrindavan . Therefore, it is also known as Nanda Bhavan or Nandalaya (the House of Nanda) . As it was one sacred day pilgrims from different places had visited this place. It was very crowded so 5-6 students decided to stay outside to take care of slippers and bags of all others who visited the temple . There were two different entrances for males and females and as doors opened after every 1 hour , the moment gates opened students went in to take blessings of the lord and came back to the main gate where there friends were already waiting for

finally all the students assembled infront of the main entrance and took auto in groups to reach near the main parking area where bus was parked. from where the journey towards the hotel in Udaipur started at around 8:30 P.M. All were tired in a day long journey but were happy too as they visited such important pilgrim that too on a pious day.

Linally the bus reached Udaipur - Hotel HOP INN . All were very hungry so rushed straight towards the dinning hall and after taking dinner went to the rooms , relaxed and enjoyed a sound sleep .

We all were very excited to explore the city. Immediately after taking breakfast we waited for our guide and started the journey the moment the guide arrived. Our guide's name was Hamendra. 1stly he took us to Saroop Sagar Lake which divides old Udaipur and new Udaipur. Asia's biggest Zinc producing company is in Udaipur which is name as India Zink limited. Zinc is used in making various ornaments, idols and show pieces.

Guide even told us about the history of Udaipur, that, It was founded in 1553 by Rana Pratap who named it Udaipur as his father's name was Udai Singh. He further told us that Udaipur is known by 4 names, namely:-

- · White city
- City of lakes (Udaipur in all has around 99 lakes)
- Arawali city (Udaipur is surrounded by Arawali mountain ranges)
- Zink city

Udaipur is also considered to be Rajasthan's Kashmir . It has a total population of around 13 to 14 lakh and entire city is directly dependent on tourism .

Time - 10:30 A.M.

Boating in Fateh Sagar Lake — Students were taken to the Fateh Sagar lake. They took us to do boating in Fateh Sagar Lake, we took a 15 minutes ride in motor boat. The ride was amazing, it wasn't too much speedy but very much enjoyable.


