Government College of Education is trying to ignite the passion of lifelong learning among the students. Learning is a precursor and outcome of effective teaching. Keeping the objective to promote learning and teaching in the best possible manner, the efforts of the college are summarized in Annual Report of the session 2020-2021.

EXAMINATION RESULTS

M.Ed., B.Ed. and PGDGC courses of study were offered during the session 2018—2020

In class M.Ed. 10 students appeared in M.Ed. (General) examinations held by Panjab University and 09 of them secured first division. Amanpreet Kaur stood first by securing 81.65% marks followed by Anupreet Kaur with 77.65% marks. Karuna Kumari stood third who scored 76.9% marks.

92students appeared in B.Ed. examinations held during 2018-2020 and 86 of them secured first division. Shobha Yadav stood first by securing 86.56% marks whereas Pansy Malhotra secured second position with 84.81% marks. Vanshika Sachdeva secured third position by securing 84.31% marks.

In class Post Graduate Diploma in Guidance and Counselling total 19 students appeared in examinations held by Panjab University and 18 of them secured first division. Ramandeep Singh stood first by securing 82.5% marks followed by Naureen Kaur with 82.0% marks. Pramod Kumar Madan stood third who scored 81.16% marks.

ACHIEVEMENTS

We take pride in the achievements and participations of our students in diverse arenas of activities. The following are the outcomes of various participations during the session 2020-2021.

The cultural activities of the new session started with the ‘**Talent Hunt**’ which was conducted during Orientation Program on January 4-5, 2021 through online mode. 43 students presented diverse items viz. RESEARCH, EXTENSION AND OUTREACHINITIATIVES

Under the able guidance and patronship of Principal Dr. A. K. Srivastava following research, extension and outreach activities were held during the session in addition to the placement, NSS and RRC activities mentioned under the respective heads:

1. A tree plantation drive was organized by NSS Wing of Government College of Education Sector-20D, Chandigarh on 04.08.2020. Dr. RenuVerma, Principal and all the staff members planted different types of trees in the college premises, in which mainly litchi, peach, pomegranate, berries, oranges, kinnu and guava were planted. Principal stated the importance of trees and plants in our lives. She encouraged the tree plantation drive and advised everyone to plant trees in their home and surroundings as well to keep the environment clean and green for healthy living.
2. A 14 day long detailed online discussion on NEP 2020 was held during September 2020. Faculty members analyzed various aspects of NEP and presented this analysis online. This programme was co-ordinated by Dr. Sheojee Singh, Associate Professor.

3. A National Webinar on the theme 'National Education Policy 2020' was organized by Govt. College of Education Sector-20 D, Chandigarh. Principal Dr. (Mrs.) Renu Verma formally inaugurated the event and welcomed the guests virtually present on the occasion. Dr. A.K. Srivastava, Dr. Lulu Ram Jakhar and Dr. Sheojee Singh organized the event and welcomed the eminent speaker Prof. Kuldeep Puri, Department of Education, Panjab University, Chandigarh. All teaching staff participated in it.
4. Red Ribbon club of the college organized an online competition for the students of B.Ed(semester II & IV) on the occasion of International Youth Day on 12th August, 2020. International Youth Day is celebrated annually on 12 August to bring youth issues to the attention of the international community and celebrate the potential of youth as partners in today's global society. The Day gives an opportunity to celebrate and mainstream young peoples' voices, actions and initiatives, as well as their meaningful, universal and equitable engagement.
5. The first session of weekly program of 'Reflections on Education' or Reading Together-Leading Together' was initiated at Government college of Education, Sector 20. Chandigarh on October 21, 2020. Srivastava, the Principal of the college congratulated, motivated and appreciated all the staff members for their contribution and support to initiate a creative effort to discuss and trace solutions to problems in the field of education. He stressed that as educationists and stakeholders it is our responsibility to share, support and strengthen the education system with our thoughtful discourses and dialogues.
6. Government College of Education" Sector 20. Chandigarh organized an e-talk entitled, 'Emotional Well Being in the COVID-19 Pandemic' for the students of B.Ed. M.Ed., and faculty members on October 24, 2020. A.K. Srivastava. Principal of the college extended a formal welcome to the speaker Dr. Renu Somal (Retd.) former HOD, Department of Psychology. COLLEGE LIBRARY

The College Library act as a Learning Resources Centre (LRC) to support the educational and research programs of the institute by providing intellectual access to information to the faculty and students for their teaching and research.

Knowing the immense significance of library, our college has been continuously trying to update the library by introducing new books and magazines. The library has 43273 books including Reference collection, Encyclopedias, Dictionaries, bound volumes of educational journals, Dissertations, Handbooks and Surveys etc.

During this session library has been renovated and keep updated by adding 1183 volumes of books procured under RUSA scheme and M&S plan. It subscribes to 64 journals and newspapers. Also library upgraded to latest LIBSYS7 (Web Centric LMS) Software, a fully JAVA/EJB and hibernate based system that provides cloud support and a web browser based user interface. It is a web based library management solution to enhance the total library experience through value added features and services.

Our college library is functioning on open access system for students and staff. The Library offers wide range of information services like reference, bibliographic, current awareness, orientation and reprographic services etc. Book Bank facility is also provided to needy students. Organization of different competitions to motivate students to use library resources has become annual feature of the library.

Library is fully computerized with 7 computers and is linked through LAN. Libsys software has been installed for library operations. In addition to computerized Issue/Return of books to students, Barcodes, Spine labels, Catalogue cards and Library Membership card (SMART CARDS) are generated through Libsys software. Library also provides OPAC AND INTERNET SERVICES to staff and students.

To get access to various e-books and e-journals library subscribes 'N-list programme of INFLIBNET' for college faculty and M.Ed. students. Users can have access to more than 6,300+ electronic journal and 31, 3500+ electronic books from anywhere using user name and password.
