3. All the T.G. Incharges will ensure that there will be an attendance register of Pre-Internship students in every school. The school will maintain the attendance record of pre-internship.



The student teachers shall observe teaching learning process for which they may use observation schedules. The institute shall develop these schedules; and orient the student teachers on the process of observation as well as use of the schedules.
2. Evaluation procedures used in the school
  - A. Types of evaluation
  - B. Maintenance of examination records
3. Library resources
4. Types of Grants and Scholarships received by school
5. Record of any one stock register
6. Visit to innovative centre of pedagogy and learning/ educational resource centre.
7. Reflections on school experiences (local schools visited)

The report should be submitted to the T.G. Incharges up to **02/05/2022** positively. Students are also required to present and share the report with the school for providing the feedback to the school.
