
Report of Orientation Programme

Orientation Programme for the newly admitted students of B. Ed.1st Semester, M. Ed. 1st Semester and PGDGC 1st Semester was organised in the College Auditorium from 27th September to 29th September, 2022. The orientation programme initiated with inaugurated of Academic session by the esteemed guest and Alumnus of the College Prof (Dr.) Kirandeep Singh of Chairperson, Department of Education, Panajb University, Chandigarh. The programme initiated with lighting of the lamp by the chief guest. The invocation of the Goddess Sarasvati was carried out by the Music students of the College accompanied by the Music staff. All the students and all the faculty members and support staff enthusiastically participated in the programme. On the occasion Chief Guest congratulated the students for choosing the noble profession of teaching and tells the students that they are lucky to be admitted in this prestigious institute of teacher education in Northern India. She also motivated the students to harness their skills and form the right attitude towards the development of human resources to change the life of their students. Welcoming the Chief Guest Dr. A. K. Srivastava, gave a brief introduction of the Chief Guest and highlighted the contributions made by Prof Kirandeep towards the development of Education at national and international level. 


