


## REPORT OF TEACHING AID COMPETITION

The competition took place in three different platforms for three groups. There were some basic instructions for the students as follows:


- Students had to switch on their Video during their Presentation.
- Students were required to provide the following details at the beginning of their presentation i.e. Topic, Name of the teaching aid, Material used and its effectiveness in classroom teaching.

The pedagogy subjects were divided into three categories:

- 1. Languages: Hindi/English/Punjabi/Sanskrit
- 2. Science /Phy. Sc./Life Sc./Home Sc./Computer Sc./Maths
- 3. Social Studies/Economics/Music/Fine Arts


Winners were declared for each category based on the number of participants. In case of less than 3 participants, only 1 prize was declared. In case of less than 5 participants, 2 prizes were declared in case of more than 5 participants, 3 prizes were declared. In case of more than 12 participants, 4 prizes were declared.




Judges Dr. Mukhtiar Singh, Dr. Lilu Ram, Dr. Ravneet Chawla judging the participants




Participant and winner Chhavi Duggal demonstrating her Teaching Aid on the Topic "Adjectives"




Participant and winner Abhilasha demonstrating her Teaching Aid on the Topic "Prepositions"




Judges Dr. Sanjeev and Dr. Sheojee Singh, Dr. Nisha Singh, Dr. Suman Khokhar judging the participants


