The Post-Graduate Institute of Medical Education Research (PGI), the premier health institution of the region, has come under scanner of the Chandigarh Pollution Control Committee (CPCC) for violating norms of the National Green Tribunal (NGT) over charge of wastewater.

The CPCC has found the PGI has been releasing untreated wastewater into the sewerage system of the Municipal Corporation for past many years.

The CPCC had issued show-cause notice to seeking an explanation why a sewerage treatment plant (STP) and an effluent treatment plant (ETP) have not been installed by the PGI, which treats the effluent from the patients from the region. The CPCC has also issued a notice to the PGI to stop discharging effluent into the sewerage system.

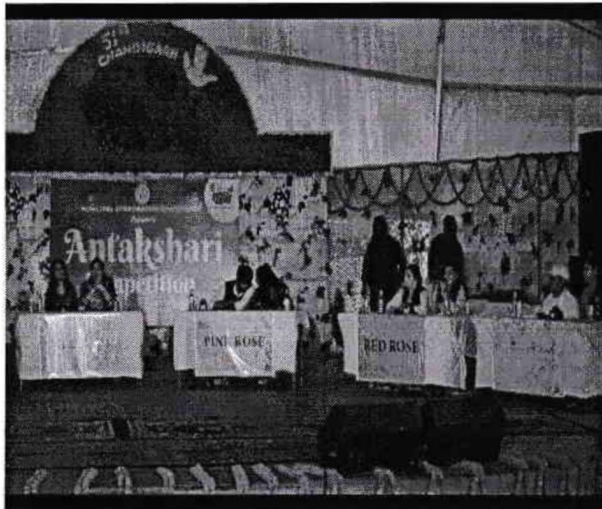

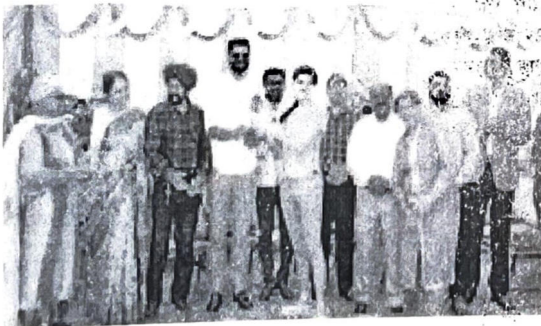
