Rules for award of Roll of Honour, College Colour and Merit Certificate 2024

General Conditions:

- 1. Awards will be given to students of outgoing batch of all the courses
- 2. Awards will constitute distinguished comprehensive achievement in academics and NSS and Cultural and Sports and / or these sub criteria and overall criteria
- 3. Only one Roll of Honour is to be awarded.
- 4. Only one college colour per students will be awarded
- 5. There should be no record of misconduct / complaints / indiscipline / any such observation during the college session including internship / field activities.
- 6. There should be no record of lecture shortage in any semester.
- 7. All house test examination should have been clearly qualified, without any absence.
- **8.** A student who achieves 3rd position at National Level in any game / sport will be considered for College Colour.
- 9. A student who achieves 3rd position at State / University Level and / or participate in any game / sport at National Level be considered for merit certificate.
- 10. A student who bags 2nd / 3rd position at University / Inter Zonal / Zonal Youth Festival and / or participates at National Level will be considered for Award of Merit Certificate.
- 11. Student failing to fulfill the above mentioned general conditions will not be considered for Roll of Honour, College colour and merit certificates.
 - The decision of the committee shall be final. They shall have discretion to approve or disapprove a nomination in favor of dignity and pride of the college.
 - A student who fulfills the University conditions (both of attendance of lectures and Result of examination (s) and his conduct has been satisfactory may be awarded, "Roll of Honour / COLLEGE COLOUR / MERIT CERTIFICATE.

RULES FOR THE AWARD OF ROLL OF HONOUR IN SPORTS

- 1. Sportsman whose name is considered for the award of Roll of Honour must be a bonafide student of the college and fulfill any one of the following conditions:-
- (a) He is a member of the National team in any game or sport.
- (b) He is a member of any state Winner or Runner's up team' in any game or sport.
- (c) He is a captain or Secretary of any P.U. Team.
- (d) He is a member of the ALL India combined University team.

- (e) He is a member of North Zone / Ranji Cricket Team.
- (f) He is a member of the North Zone-Inter-University-Winner or Runners up
- (g) He is a member of the ALL India. Inter-Varisity Winner or Runner's up team.
- (h) In Athletics and swimming or Boxing/wresting he must have secured first or second position in the National or State or ALL India Inter-University Meets.
- (i) Creation of a new record in the Panjab University, state or National Meets.
- (j) Students found guilty of misconduct/misbehavior/ use of unfair means in the examination will not be eligible for the award of Roll of Honour.
- (k) The decision with regard to award of Roll of Honour will rest with the Principal.

RULES FOR THE AWARD OF COLLEGE COLOUR

College colour is to be awarded to a bonafide player of the college, who is:-

- (a) A member of the State/University team in any game/ sports.
- (b) Winner of any individual event in the University Tournament.
- (c) Member of the Winner or Runners up team in the Panjab University Tournament.
- (d) The Best Athlete of the college.
- (e) Award of College colour is subject to consistent good conduct of the student considered eligible otherwise.

RULES FOR THE AWARD OR MERIT CERTIFICATES IN SPORTS AND **GAMES**

- (a) A student who has acted as Captain or Secretary of any college team.
- (b) Best Player in any game or sports who has played for the college
- (c) A student who has been selected by the Panjab University to attend the Panjab University coaching camp in any game or sports.
- (d) A student who has been regularly playing the game and represented the college in University / District tournament.

RULES FOR AWARD OF "ROLL OF HONOUR"

ACTIVITIES: NSS and Co-Curricular.

- 1. No student who has punished for misconduct will be awarded a college colour/ Roll of Honour.
 - (a) A student achieves distinction in an activity held at National / Zonal / Inter-University Level.
 - (b) He achieves a "Colour" from the University (Participating with permission of the Principal).

RULES FOR AWARD OF "COLLEGE COLOUR"

Activity: NSS and Other Co-Curricular Activities

- (1) He participates in an activity held at National / Zonal / Inter-Varsity level.
- (2) He achieves distinction in an activity held at State/ University (Inter Zonal)./ Directorate Level.
- (3) Any student who secures first place in a University / Inter Zonal Youth festival may be awarded a college colour.
- (4) He / She has bagged four first prizes in inter-college contest.
- (5) He / She has bagged 1st and 2nd place in PU Zonal Youth Festival
- (6) He / She has bagged 2nd place in PU Inter-Zonal Youth Festival.

Distinction will not imply mere participation in any activity.

RULES FOR AWARD OF MERIT CERTIFICATE

- (1) He / She has been office bearers of a society or club in the college for the session.
- (2) He / She has bagged any three prizes in an inter-college contest.
- (3) He / She must have been declared best volunteer.
- (4) He / She has bagged third place in PU Zonal / Inter-Zonal Youth Festival.
